**Summary/Purpose:**

As a Vehicle Driver, the chosen candidate will work in a team setting to achieve warehouse and overall Foodbank operational goals. He will safely operate an RBFB vehicle to accurately and efficiently transport fresh, frozen and/or processing product to multiple agencies within our service area. He will become part of an experienced team doing its part to help end hunger within the RBFB service area.

**Essential job functions**

- Timely and professional execution of product donation pickups and deliveries to agencies for the River Bend Foodbank.
- Promptly and safely load and unload trucks on location and at delivery sites
- Ability to move product using a forklift and/or pallet jack
- Provide excellent customer service to donors and their employees as well as to partner agencies to foster continued support and a professional working relationship
- Complete and perform accurate follow-through on documentation for shipping, receiving, loading and warehousing of product as defined by RBFB policies and procedures
- Comply with safety policies and programs developed for vehicle and warehouse operations
- Maintain and ensure the accuracy of vehicle mileage and fuel logs as required by the RBFB and State Regulatory entities.
- Inspect product donations to ensure that safety and sanitation standards are met
- Be familiar with and comply with all aspects of the Foodbank’s Food Safety Programs, Policies and Procedures.
- Perform routine inspections, cleaning and light preventative maintenance on vehicles and equipment, reporting problems and concerns immediately to the Director of Operations
- Assist other warehouse staff with their responsibilities as directed by the Director of Operations
- Maintain all current licenses, certifications and medical cards in accordance/compliance with RBFB, State and Federal mandated requirements
- Other Duties as Assigned.

The River Bend Foodbank warehouse hours are 6:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. and office hours are 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. The normal workday will be 8 hours a day Monday through Friday between 6:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. A set schedule will be provided at the time of your interview. The nature of our operation requires that work hours may vary and occasionally include Saturdays. There may be an opportunity to work limited overtime.
